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

Note:-

1. The colleges have to collect and remit the fee as prescribed by the University.
2. The Principals are requested to allot the invigilation work to the teachers of major subjects such as Commerce, Management, English, Mathematics, Economics, etc., in the beginning of the of the theory examination and relieve them immediately for evaluation work.
3. The Principal are further requested to compulsorily collect the evaluation attendance certificates from all the teachers who attended evaluation work in different subjects and produce them before the local inquiry committees for verification at the time of visit.
4. During vacation, it is mandatory for teachers to undertake theory valuation and practical examination related work assigned by the University. Otherwise disciplinary action will be initiated for dereliction of duty, in the case of University / Government / aided and unaided college teachers for not attending to the examination work which is one of the conditions to continue affiliation and to announce the results of students of these colleges.
5. Wherever Bio-Metric attendance is implemented, the Principals are requested to take permission from their higher authorities to waive the requirement of attendance of the teachers on the days of the examination related work in the University especially during the evaluation of answer books.
